HOTEL ACCOMODATION AND CONVENTION FEE

HOW TO ARRIVE

- **By car:** from the **NORTH** of Italy, highway A3 Salerno-Reggio Calabria way out Lagonegro nord, then motorway Fondo Valle del Noce until the crossway with S.S.18, conducing directly to Scalea.
- **From the SOUTH** of Italy, highway A3 way out Falerna; then continue on the motorway Tirrenica for the SS18 up to Scalea.
- **By plane:** call at Lamezia Terme (about 120 km from Scalea) or Naples (about 225 km from Scalea)
- **By train:** direct connection from Rome with Scalea.

Hotel Village Club: it arises directly on the beach in the most famous Riverside of Cedars (international known for the Rabbi reapings of cedars for the Sukkoth feast) and it is composed by two bodies united by a tunnel shopping centre. The structure is situated in a park of 40.000 mq and is able to offer its numerous services in the greatest quietness and in the respect of the personal privacy. A wide and beautiful beach of sand and gravel is reserved only to the Hotel guests.

All the 380 rooms are supplied of private services, telephone, balcony and tv color. Different are the common spaces able to secure the maximum comfort to the guests:

2 large dining rooms for 300/1100 persons, amusement arcade, TV room, restaurant, disco pub, 2 swimming pools, 3 bars, elevators, gym. On the outside the Centre has a theatre, basket/volley playgrounds, tennis, bowls, soccer, archery.

The kitchen will be held by reknown chef in the respect of the local and national tradition.

The Convention Centre is one of the most equipped of the South; it has a wide hall, with a capacity of 1500 places. There are also other halls next to the big one.

WORKSHOP



It will be proposed a workshop of practical dance, led by CARLA PADOVANI (Artistic Director of the *Terra di Danza* company) and her team. The association gathers international known dancers, musicians, choreographers and artists. It will be presented a program of traditional Jewish dances, applied to the biblical Psalms and Klezmer music (song leader). From the XV century, in the Western Europe ghettos, groups of popular musicians began to play their music in the Synagogue and in the village feasts (*shell*).



Sometimes they produce themselves also for the Christians, acting as cultural link. If it is true that the music is the soul mirror, then the Klezmer music is certainly the mirror of the Jewish soul. It is inspired to the profane songs and the traditional dances, but also to the Synagogue prayers. With its rhythm variation, its dissonances and a part of improvisation, it incites to dance and it allows to express all the emotions, from the joy to the sadness, from the unrestraintness to the gathering.
